Readiness for Competitive Exam





Cosmo Foundation, Karjan has been conducting specialized coaching sessions for students preparing for the Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya competitive exams for the last 6 months. 56 rural students appeared for the exams on 20th January 2024 in Karjan. For the pre-readiness, a parent's meeting was organized on a virtual platform and they were oriented to examination guidelines, professor to acquire call letters, and last-minute assistance required to be given to students by parents for the exams.

"Navodaya classes have had a significant impact, not only on the academic progress of our children but also on their overall development. We have observed a noticeable enhancement in their conceptual understanding facilitated bv mental agility proficiency in solving complex numerical questions. Running a classes on online platform has brought about a substantial transformation in our children's skills to learn effectively through digital medium. This is the only coaching avilable in karjan for competitive exams and that too free of cost".









EMPOWERMENT



Empowering Rural Girls with Soft Skill Training

As part of the celebration of "National Girl Child Day" on January 24th, Cosmo Foundation, in collaboration with "The Core Teamwork" Delhi, organized a webinar on a digital platform. 300 rural girls representing from 9 high schools of Gujarat and Maharashtra along with 55 community based teachers of CF participated. The theme of the event was "Mann Main Hai Vishwas," aimed at building self-respect, self-confidence, the significance of education and skill enhancement for girls and gender equality were emphasized by experts. During the webinar, examples of Indian role models such as Kalpana Chawla, Mary Kom, and Sindhutai were presented along with creative exercises.

Internship at Cosmo Foundation

During this month we have 9 interns from Masters in Social Work, Masters in Human Resource Management, and the Masters of Extension and Communication. They are engaged in organizing cleanliness campaigns, documenting testimonials, digital literacy, and producing resource materials for educational programs. Nichita a research student, designed 25 files of teaching aids to promote Computer Literacy for rural schools students from Karjan taluka. She conducted a pilot study on the impact of IEC materials with 160 students of grade 6 to 8 followed by teachers training. Her primary focus was on enhancing skills in digital art and Microsoft Word.

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Road safety Awareness - Aurangabad




